CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter presents the research context, research focuses, research objective, significance of study, scope and limitation, and definition of the key terms which involved in this research.

A. Research Context

Speaking is a tool of communication because someone can deliver the ideas and aspiration by using his/her voice to say. Beside that someone also can express their feeling and opinion whatever and whenever. We have know that by language we are able to express our own opinion by using language that we have, so from of thing that we have know speaking is really important in our daily activity.

Speaking is a way to express our mind or idea. This statement supported by Colie and Stepend that speaking is called by oral communication or word expression the mind, idea, and feeling. English as a foreign language, commonly most of students have some problems in teaching learning. Here, to teach speaking skill teacher use Think Pair Share (TPS) technique. Think Pair Share (TPS) technique is a technique to teach the students' speaking where this technique help them to able deliver opinion. According to Think Pair Share (TPS) Technique is a technique designed to provide students to think a given topic by enabling them to formulate individual ideas and share these ideas with another student. This technique is a learning technique developed by Lyman to encourage student classroom participation. Think Pair Share technique is a cooperative discussion technique to help students work in group. In applying this technique, the teacher poses a question, preferable one demanding analysis, evaluation, or synthesis, and gives students about a minute to think through an appropriateresponse.²

After doing observation, the researcher interview to the teacher who teach English, namely RusmaniatilLaily,S.Pd that students of ZEMA English Study Center have been difficult in English material especially in speaking skill. She

So that, she choose the technique than can be students focus and enjoy in the class and they can deliver their opinions when the teacher ask is think pair share technique.³

There is previous study that related with this research. The research is conducted by RobiArdianto (2018) "The Implementation of TPS (Think-Pair-Share) Strategies In Reading Comprehension To The Students At Eleventh of Grade **SMA** PlusMiftahulUlumToronan Bara' LekeLaranganBadungPalengaanPamekasan". He found that using TPS (Think Pair Share) in the teaching and learning process in reading comprehension give some advantages and good responses from the students. The advantages are: Students are able to increase their own knowledge, students are able to learn new higher level thinking fom their pair and friends, active discussion make all of students participate, a same oppoturnity between the ordinary students and the clever students to share they ideas.⁴

Other previous study did by Abdurrahman HjUsman, S.Pd, SH, M.Pd. from State Islamic Institute (IAIN) Ternate, his research about "Using the Think-Pair-Share Strategy to Improve students' Speaking ability at Stain Ternate". He used quantitative research approach to observe it. In his

observation result showed that the strategy is effective because there was a significant improvement performed by the students from Cycle 1 to Cycle 2. The students' significant improvement was indicated theindicators of the criteria of success.
