CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

The discussion of this chapter is about research context, research focuses, research objectives, significance of the study, scope and limitation, and definition of key terms.

A. Research Context

Pronunciation is the study about ordinance of uttering the words in a variety of different ways. When considering meaning, we see how using one sound rather than another can change the meaning of the word. It means that we must speak clearly to avoid misunderstanding. So pronunciation is the way in which a particular word or sound is pronunced. One way to correct pronunciation is by frequently opening a dictionary and listening in English. The study pronunciation consists of two fields, the are phonetics and phonology. Phonetics is study about speech sounds, whereas phonology is study how to speak language or systematize sound. Most students find it difficult to say the words in English because of the absence of supportive habits and methods.

Phonology consists of two ways, the first is segmental features it is consists of two categories, consonant and vowels. The second one is suprasegmental features it is includes intonation and stress.⁴ Vowel sounds are all voiced and unvoiced. While vowels are single vowel (short and long)

diphthongs. In stress includes word stress and sentence stress, it can find proper noun, principle verb, adjective and adverb.

Teaching pronunciation must have a good basic in pronunciation. Teachers also need to consider how the sounds we use come about, and to study the physiology which allows use to use those sounds.⁵ It is important to learn, because pronunciation is one aspect to support English skill. Teachers should be able to pronounce their English well for their students' pronounces.

Cognitive psychology is the study of mental processes. Which includes determaining the characteristics and properties of the mind and how it operates. It is mean that to describing how cognitive psychology approach the scientific study of mind. In learning psychology contains such areas of behavior learning theory, cognitive learning theory, humanism learning theory and contructive learning theory.⁶

Cognitive learning theory is the process of giving new knowledge to adjust the knowledge already possessed by the student. It means that a teacher must have an ability in material mastery. In general, cogtitive is defined a intellectual potential of stages: knowledge, understanding, application, analysis, synthetis, evaluation. Cognitive is a problem that involves the ability to develop rational (sense) abilities.⁷ It means that cognitive is a person who already has an early knowledge, which in the

teacher learning process would link student new knowledge with the student's old knowledge. This view has led to several ideas that are importants for teachers and for our teaching practices.

There are four of the most important for teachers and for our teaching practices inlude: (1) human intellegence is not a unitary ability but instead has multiple dimentions, (2) the human memory system structures learner's abilities to gather information from the environment, procss it, and store it for later use and transfer, (3) what learners already know is the most important and critical element in ehat they will learn, and (4) when learners develop metacognitive knowledge they become aware of their cognitive processes, can monitor progress toward particular learning goals, and can employ appropriate learning strategies to enhance learning.⁸

Teachers generally agree on the importance of concept learning, problem solving, transfer, and metacognition. The teacher can identify the student's problem in pronunciation in order to overcome quickly and properly. The student needs to know many element of English such as sound, stress and intonation, roots, and the silent letters. Teachers should be able to demonstrate how to pronounce well.

According to Piaget, he believes that we are adjusting in two ways to assimilation and accommodations. Assimilation occurs when individuals incorporate new information into their existing knowledge, while accommodations are happening when individuals adapt to new information.

SMPI At-Tablighiyah is one of Islamic junior high schools in Ponjanan Timur, Batumarmar, Pamekasan. It is a basic Islamic school because it has boarding school. There are three grades in this school that are

X, XI, and XII classes. In these grades are distinguished between female and male. The researcher would conduct in one class, exactly in the eighth grade of female class.

The researcher interviewed one of the students from this school, she said that having difficulties to pronunce the words correctly. The reseacher found out that the students often make mistakes of pronounce some words. When the students say, for example "busy" she pronunce same word is "busy" but the correct is /'blzi/, the researcher told how to pronunce and she can pronunce well. As researcher mentioned before it is called using cognitive learning. Cognitive theory includes scientific studies of the symptoms of mental life insofar as it relates to the way humans think in gaining knowledge, processing impressions that enter through the senses, problem solving. 12

There are some researchers who have conducted a research about pronunciation ability, one of them is Kamilatuz Zahrah the title is "The Implementation Of Teaching Pronunciation by Using Recording Technique at Ainul Falah English Course (AFEC) Bakiong Guluk-Guluk Sumenep.¹³ Her research is telling about the implementation of recording technique by the teacher in teaching pronunciation to improve student's pronunciation both in their reception and in their own production. While from the

So the researcher is interested in the research with the title "Analysis Cognitive Learning Theories Used by English Teacher in Teaching Pronunciation in English Subject at The Eighth Grade in SMPI At-Tablighiyah East Ponjanan Batumarmar".

B. Research focus

- 1. What are the type of cognitive learning theories used by the teacher in teaching pronunciation in English subject at the eighth grade in SMPI At-Tablighiyah?
- 2. What is the most popular of cognitive learning theories used by the teacher in teaching pronunciation based on the students in English subject at the eighth grade in SMPI At-Tablighiyah?
