CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

It is the same as Douglas Bibel' opinion, he stated that Words can be organized into higher units, known as phrase⁵. So, If we want to say something, we have to know first what thing we are going to say in order to avoid a wrong utterance which is influenced by doubt or wrong meaning.

According to Adward D. Johnshon states in his book that grammar is system of inflections (change the form of word, such as to show whether noun is singular or plural) and syntax (the order of the words in sentence) that make it possible to form sentence out of words.⁶ It means that grammar is one of important elements in language which should be understood and mastered by the students if they want to speak English correctly.

In the previous researcher by Muhammad Rosidi in his thesis, he said as the result of his thesis that there are many problems which are faced by the students during teaching learning process such as problem in learning and

Most of students do not know how to analyze noun phrase. They get confused in understanding kinds of phrases, component of noun phrase, and it's functions. The phenomenoun happened to students of MTs AL-IKHSAN because they are a beginer and English is a foreign language for them. Whereas, grammar is a basic skill to write and speak English correctly because it correlates with the rules in English language. It is almost the same as Zainuddin MS' opinion. He stated that The result of this research showed the students got the difficulties to tell about their unforgettable exprience, it is because of the students dislike english and the students also did not understand about english especially grammar. There were some kinds of grammatical errors that the students made when the students told about their unforgettable exprience, such as: Omission errors, Addition errors, and misinformation errors. And Atika said that The result of this research is there are many students that showed on the study of students learning difficulties on grammar. The causes of the students difficulties low motivation to study about grammar, unsuportived from their environment and also the teaching process is not interested by students. It is suggested for the english teacher to be more creative to teach the student. It should be appropriate with the students' level in order it can run well and the students are motivated to study about grammar well. The researcher conclude that the students' difficulties are confused in putting the preposition, confused in searching and selecting the correct preposition, there are too many preposition, and the last because many prepositions have the same meaning and function". But base on research above, the researcher wants to focus to research about the students difficulties and adjective phrase faced by students of A class in Banyuanyar English Center (BEC).

Many students of The A Class In Banyuanyar English Center (BEC)have some problems in mastering grammatical rules especially in phrase mastery. They can not determine a phrase in a sentence and also they can not arrange words correctly. Most of students do not know how to analyze a phrase. They get confused in understanding kinds of phrases and it's functions.
