CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Research Context

Language is the center of education, a means of communication education content and an important object in education. In languages, we can learn many languages, for example is English. English has four types of basic skills, there are listening, speaking, reading and writing.¹ Listening is an activity to get the meaning, speaking is used voice to say something, writing is a process to express an opinion, statement and knowledge using written text, and reading is an activity to search for some information or knowledge.²

Grabe and Stoller state that reading is a way to draw meaning or information from the printed page and interpret it correctly.³ Therefore reading is one of the things that greatly influence the knowledge of information for students. Another explanation, Reading is a means of language acquisition, communication, sharing information and ideas.⁴ According to the thesis of Rila Apriltya she said, "Reading is not just translating. But reading is related to the process of comprehension and thinking to get meaning from the text". Reading comprehension is a process of extracting and constructing meaning through interactions with written language. While reading is thinking, students need to

have a comprehension of the text being read.⁵ Reading is a very important activity for a student. Through reading, students are required to think and comprehension about everything in the text such as meaning and information.

Comic strip is a form of comic consisting of several sheets of a frame that are published in a daily or magazine, usually connected to the story.⁶ According to the thesis of Muhammad Muhajirin he said, comic strips are unique and interest stories that grow out of the life and imagination of people or the animal were made with a variety of image and event in it.⁷ Other explanation comic strips are illustrated stories using several panels whose contents have several characters. Thinking and speaking characters are marked by using 'balloon - balloon' in which there are writings from the conversation.

According to The Writers Union, comic strips made up of multiple panels (often 3-4, but sometimes up to a page) that are published in multiple places, with the copyright remaining with a single body such as the writer or an agency.⁸ The definition above is also appropriate as found on comic strips according to Ohio State University Cartoon Research Library is a series of images that tell stories written and drawn by cartoon artists published through newspapers and on the internet. The comic strip tells about an event, adventure or mystery story, etc.⁹

While the value of comic media education as a learning process according to Sudjana and Rivai states that comic media in the learning process can create interest in students, such as streamlining the teaching and learning process, can increase interest in learning and generate interest in appreciation.¹⁰ The phenomenon in this research is in learning English, most students feel bored, not interested when told to read, they have difficulty understanding because the writing is too much so that they feel dizzy in reading. F. The Definition of Key Term

1. Definition of Comic Strips

Strip comics consist of two words, comic and strip. Comics in the book of Kamus Besar Bahasa Indonesia (KBBI) means pictorial stories (magazines, newspapers or book form).¹⁶ A comic is an art form in the form of pictures arranged in such a way that it will form a storyline. Generally, comics are printed and published on sheets of paper and enclosed with text. Comics are usually published in various forms such as strips in newspapers, magazines and even in the form of books.¹⁷

2. Definition of Reading Comprehension

Snow defined reading comprehension as the process of simultaneously extracting and constructing meaning through interaction and involvement with written language.¹⁸

Narrative is a piece of the text which tells a story and entertains or informs the reader.¹⁹
