CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Research Context

The similarity is to improve students pronunciation by using or listening music or song, and the differences of the research of the previous study is used Classroom Action Research (CAR) while in this research the researcher used qualitative descriptive in doing research.

The researcher conduct a research about "The use of English song lyric in teaching listening for ninth grade tudents at SMP Annidhamiyah Bindang, Pasean, Pamekasan" Basically, this study is almost the same to teach listening skill.
