Utilize technology should be 'apply technology' or 'exploit technology' because the word technology does not collocate with the word utilize.

c. Third writing

Do a crime should be 'carry out a crime' or 'commit a crime' because the word crime does not collocate with the word do.

Fetch money should be 'bring in money' or 'get money' because the word money does not collocate with the word fetch
