CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter covers discussion about research context, research problems, research objective, significance of research, the definition of key terms and previos study.

A. Research Context

Speaking is the ability to pronounce articulation sounds or words to express, state, and convey thoughts, ideas, and feelings, Nurgiyantoro added that speaking is a second language activity that humans do in language life after listening. To be able to speak a language well, the speaker must master the pronunciation, structure, and vocabulary. Concerned. In addition it is also necessary to master the problem or idea that will be conveyed and the ability to understand the other persons language.¹

Speaking is to communicate directly between the speaker and listener in order to find information so that the listener can take and use the information. The essence of the purpose of speaking itself is speaking activities to entertain, inform, stimulate, convince and move. In order to convey thoughts effectively. The speaker must understand the meaning of everything he wants to communication on the listener and must be aware of all speech situation, both in general and individually.²

Speaking is a language skill that is developed in a child's life, which comes from listening skills. So that speaking skills have a more profound impact on student growth. Speaking skills not only improve pronunciation but also in grammar, vocabulary and listen. Talking is a productive skill. That is it cannot be separated from listening. When we speak, we produce text and it has to be meaningful. The nature of communication, we can find speakers, listeners, messages and responses from the speaker. Talking cannot be separated from pronunciation because it will motivate learners to learn English sounds.³ Speaking skills are not easy and simple, either for the teacher or for students. Regarding the importance of speaking skills, the National curriculum has defined these skills to be taught, applied in teaching , learning and learning process. In fact, the National curriculum has put in place English as one the important subjects to be taught in schools starting from TK, SMP, SMA AND UNIVERSITY although the National curriculum requires students to learn English, however the implementation of teaching and learning skills in this school is still problematic. Many students still do not have the ability to use English both inside and outside the classroom.⁷

Method use storytelling because this method has parallels with previous fairy tales sleep that is usually done by parents in acients times to develop imagination, fantasy and memory that can leade children on good understanding. Through the storytelling method, students can understand the stories told by the learners easily, they too will feel interested and happy with the story that is listened to because the learner storytelling expressively, thus learners can improve their the ability to understand the content of the story throught the storytelling method.¹⁰

Storytelling is a productive language activity. That is, in storytelling someone involves thoughts, mental readiness, courage, clear words. So that others can understand it.¹¹

Storytelling is an activity that is carried out by one person orally to another with a tool about what must be conveyed in the form of messages, information or just a fairy tale that is packaged in the form of a story that can be listened to with a sense of fun.¹²
