CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

This chapter present about conclusion and suggestion based on the result of the research. The conclusion is related with the findings of research in the focus after the researcher analyzed types of speech acts used by Ahmed Deedat in his speech.

1. Types of speech acts spoken by Ahmed Deedat

The data of this research are classified based on the theory of speech acts that are proposed by Searle. The findings of this research show that there are five types of speech acts found in Ahmed Deedat speech, they are: assertive, directive, commisive, expressive, and declarative. Ahmed Deedat as the speaker usually used the assertive function when he performed his speech. He also often used the directive function. Then, the next types of illocutionary acts rarely used by the speaker when he performed a speech is declarative. Finally, the last illocutionary acts that were very rarely used were expressive and commisive

2. Most dominant kind of speech acts used by Ahmed Deedat in his speech

The most dominant kind of speech acts used based on table 2 is assertive. In "What the Bible says about Muhammad", assertive has 61,1%. Quran a Miracle of Miracles has 66,7% assertives, Muhammad The Greatest has 66,7% assertives, Islam and Other Religions has 64,3% assertives, and Christ in Islam has 87,5% assertives.

B. Suggestion

As result which has described in this research, there are some suggestions attention needed:

1. Suggestion for reader

The readers should know how important speech acts in some utterances.

2. Suggestion for further researcher

Because of the limitation of the researcher, it is suggested that other researchers to conduct their investigation in the similar field related to speech acts but on other objectives. It is expected that the knowledge of speech acts will be more developed.
