

# CHAPTER I

## INTRODUCTION

In this chapter the researcher explains about research context, research problems, research objective, significance of study, scope and limitation, and definition of key terms.

### **A. Research Context**

The impact of the Covid-19 virus has created an online learning system for education. The researcher translate it into English like this, teachers can be understood as people who teach at certain places, provide additional formal education and provide regular therapy in the mosque as well as at home.<sup>1</sup> In addition, learning by means of technology-based discussions can improve the perception of educators in facilitating the dissemination of information to students and communication with them, an educators can start planning to use technology in teaching.<sup>2</sup> It can be concluded that the teacher must use technology as a means of learning in interacting with students, so that the teacher can convey the material well and have discussions or questions and answers with the learning material.

In this study, researcher used Narrative text to knowing students understanding in online learning. Reading will make students remember and understand the material more. A student who loves reading and spends a lot of time in reading activity also has ability to write well. By reading, students can improve their vocabulary and writing skill. On the countraty, a student who has low reading ability will find difficulty in learning process.<sup>5</sup> The use of reading text in online learning can help students understand the material and continue with discussions with the teacher through the media used.

processing comprehend the text and understand its meaning to get the information from the text.

The researcher uses Narrative text to know the students' understanding in reading the text. A narrative text is a text in which an agent or subject conveys to an addressee (tell the readers) a story in particular medium, such as language, imagery, sound, buildings, or a combination thereof. A story is the content of the text, and produces a particular manifestation, inflection, and colouring of a *fabula*, *fabula* is presented in a certain manner. A *fabula* is a series of logically and chronologically related events that are caused or experienced by actors.<sup>9</sup> It can be concluded that Narrative text is the author's imagination is made into a story but is not proven to be true.

Based on the discussion above, the researcher found the thesis that has similarity to this research is about "Students Difficulties in Reading Comprehension at the First Grade of SMAN 1 Darussalam Aceh Besar". In this thesis Dasrul Hidayati used five aspects of reading comprehension in this test. The five aspects of reading comprehension were determining main idea, making inference, identifying reference, finding specific information, and understanding meaning of words or vocabulary. After analysing the data, Dasrul Hidayati giving reasons factors why the students face difficulties in answering reading comprehension test. That is, the students poor vocabulary, poor mastery of grammar, difficult to understand long sentences and text. The
