Iyus : ya I know haha so you are the winner I guest hahaha


Speaker 1 : hahaha



Speaker 10 : yes yes



There are casual and formal style that they used. Many speakers used casual, because in this application we just have random topic and that topic just for refresh their mind or need some friend to talk. But some of them will use two language style on same people with other topic, because when we make a conversation that will have a random topic and sometimes will change to serious topic and not too serious.

In this section presents the discussion based on finding of the study.

The researcher tries to explain and describe related with the use of language style on Ome TV users on speaking skill. The researcher explains below:

#### a. Speaker 1 from Indonesia in other country

Based on the first data, the speaker 1 used casual language data. This casual style uses a lot of short words. The vocabulary is full of regional dialect and language elements. It is usually apply in daily conversation,

in relaxed situation such as take a rest. When he speak with the researcher, the speaker 1 just make a random conversation. This proves that the speaker there in relax situation and just have short word while he give me some quote that he got in other people. For casual it was showed by him "keep it bro, it is good for you." Based on joos theory, "Bro" It is usually applied in daily conversation, in relaxed situation such as take a rest.

Based on the fourth data. The speaker 4 used casual and formal language style. This casual style uses a lot of short words. The vocabulary is full of regional dialect and language elements. It is usually apply in daily conversation, in relaxed situation such as take a rest. For formal language style it is used in the formal events, talks about the serious problem. Formal style is the style used in meetings, lectures, history books and others. Formal style patterns and rules have been established as a standard. This formal style is basically the same as frozen style only used in official situations and not in an unofficial
