CHAPTER I

This is so important to explain the reasons for the research and to explain the focus to be studied in the research process. The Implementation of Comic Books Media in Reading Ability at The Ninth Grade of SMP Nurul Islam Pasanggar Pegantenan Pamekasan.

A. Research Context

Language naturally becomes the most important part of human life. In fact, humans become social creators who cannot be part of other people. Language is one of the most unique human abilities of our species, and it involves all others, including consciousness, sociality and culture. We use symbolic language systems to create meaning and communicate with our fellow human beings. All people in the world, in all aspects of their daily life, naturally wish to do many things in their life. After all, language has been the only aspect that differentiates humans from other creatures like plants and animals.

Language is the ability to acquire and use complex communication systems, especially the human ability to do so, and language is a clear example of such a system. Language is not only means of communication but also builds economic relationship, friendship, and culture¹. Mostly

Nelson Francis statement in Mulyadi that language is an arbitrary system of articulated sounds made to use by a group of human as a means of carrying of the affairs to their society².

Language educators have long used the concepts of four basic language skills: Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing. These four language skills are sometimes called the "macro-skills". This is in contrast to the "micro-skills" such as grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation and spelling. The four basic skills are related to each other by two parameters: the mode of communication: oral or written and the direction of communication: receiving or producing the message. Listening comprehension is the receptive skill in the oral mode. When we speak of listening what we really mean is listening and understanding what we hear. Speaking is the productive skill in the oral mode. It, like the

other skills, is more complicated than it seems at first and involves more than just pronouncing words. Speaking is often connected with listening. For example, the two-way communication makes up for the defect in communicative ability in the traditional learning³.

Reading is a tool of communication in written language through the texts form. It is the most efficient way to gain information about many aspects of life, including science and technology. By reading, people can absorb a number of information. Reading has a very important role and becomes a daily necessity for every person who wants to acquire whatever information which is required. Reading is an essential skill for learners of English as a sforeign language. For most of learners it is the most important skill to master in order to ensure success not only in learning English, but also in learning in any content class where reading in English is required. With strengthened reading skills, learners will make greater progress and development in all other areas of learning⁴.

There are several ways to help students improve reading comprehension. One of the ways is to use interesting teaching materials. In this study, the researchers wanted to use English comics. As Hornby describes it, the comic book is a series of drawings arranged in coherent panels, with brief humor in narrative form, often serialized with balloons and text in the title. Furthermore, Liu points out, comics are highly visual

texts; they are effective, especially for reading comprehension for learners of a second or other language. To sum up, because it is in the form of the same amount of pictures and texts, comics can attract students' attention more than prints. By prioritizing reading as a goal of student mastery, the current presence of media can contribute positively to children and make them happy. Using media can help students develop their language skills and help students interpret and remember the stories contained within⁵.

According to Harmer reading is one of the receptive skills of English. Yet, the four language skills are closely related to each other. The ability to read texts in English is important as a bridge to understand the textbook⁶. If students continue their studies to the senior high school and university, they are required to understand many books written in English.

SMP Nurul Islam is an educational unit at the junior high school level in Pasanggar, Kec. Pegantenan, Kab. Pamekasan. In carrying out its activities, SMP Nurul Islam is under the auspices of the Ministry of Religion. The Nurul Islam Middle School Foundation is an Islamic-oriented institution. It is located 100m to the west from the village hall of Pasanggar, Pegantenan, Pamekasan. This institution is led by Mr. Mohammad Sukri.S.Pd, he is the principal of SMP Nurul Islam. The Nurul Islam Foundation has seven institutions, namely: PAUD Nurul Islam, RA Al wada', MD Nurul Islam, TK Nurul Islam, MI Mambaul Ulum, SMP Nurul Islam, SMK Nurul Islam. Here the researcher is interested in conducting

- What are the advantages and disadvantages of comic books media in reading ability at the ninth grade of SMP Nurul Islam Pasanggar Pegantenan Pamekasan?

3. Comic Books is stories that are illustrated with pictures and serve to entertain the reader.

G. Previous Study

Researched by Intan Setyaningrum. This research is about "Effect of English Comics on Reading Comprehension of 8th Grade Students in SMPN 11 Mataram 2018/2019". The purpose of this study was to find out if there was a significant difference in improving students' reading ability with and without comics. The researchers used an experimental approach that included pre-test and post-test designs and treatments for this study. The subjects of this study were all eighth-grade students. A total of 58 students from two grades were used as samples. VIII E was the experimental group and VIII B was the control group. The technique used to analyze the data is the t-test formula.

The results of this research showed that the mean deviations of the pre-test and post-test in the experimental group were higher than those in the control group. This is also supported by the t-score, which is higher than the t-table. Therefore, rejecting the null hypothesis (Ho) and accepting the alternative hypothesis (Ha) shows that the English comic is effective in improving student's reading comprehension was accepted. Based on this finding, it is suggested that English comic can be used by English teachers as an alternative reading materials to improve the students' reading comprehension.

And the second previous study is researched by Wahyu Nuning Budiarti. The title is "Developing Comic Books to Increase Motivation to

Learn And Reading Comprehension For The Fourth Grade Students of Elementary School". This research aims to evelop an comic books that is eligible for the fourth grade students of elementary school, (2) reveal the effectiveness of the developed comic books toward enchancement of student motivation to learn, and enchancement of student reading comprehension. This developmental research refers to the model from Borg & Gall, consist of (1) research & information collecting, (2) planning, (3) develop preliminary form of product, (4) preliminary field testing, (5) main product revision, (6) main field testing, (7) operational product revision, (8) operational field revision, (9) final product revision, (10) dissemination and implementation. The subject of the operational field testing consists of 27 as the experimental class and 27 students as the control class. The research finding reveals that the comic books is proper for the fourth grade students of elementary school.(1) According to the expert of the material and the expert of the educational media, the comic books product is categorized into "good". (2) There is an increase in the pretest to posttest at control class and experimental class of motivation for study after using comic books, and reading comprehension after using comic books for study. Overall test and the results showed that the comic books take effect that positive and significant to student's motivation to learn and student"s reading comprehension.

In this study there are differences between the research of the researcher and one of the researchers, namely Intan Setyaningrum, a journal entitled The Use of English Comics in Reading Comprehension (An

Experimental Research at Eighth Year Students of SMPN 11 Mataram in the Academic Year(2018/2019), in her research uses quantitative methods while researchers use qualitative methods that there will definitely be differences in the way in obtaining data. The similarities between her research and this research are using English comic books as learning media. And the differences between the second previous study are using Indonesian comic, while in this research use English comic. This research discuss about how comic books are effective as learning media. Meanwhile, in his research discuss about how comic books can motivate students to read. The big difference between their research and this research is the media used, they use comics which are not specific to comic books, while this research uses comic book media. Therefore, researchers are very interested in examining the implementation of comic books media that would be carried out at SMP Nurul Islam with the chosen title "The Implementation Of Comic Books Media In Reading ability at the Ninth Grade of SMP Nurul Islam Pasanggar Pegantenan Pamekasan".
