CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter is divided into two part. Namely conclusion and suggestion. The conclusion deals with the result of the research about analysis of satire on Simon Armitages's Five poem. The suggestion is given to the student, reader and next researcher.

A. Conclusion

After answering the research focus by collecting and analysing the data, the researcher can conclude that there are 40 data which are include into type and function of satire. Namely the types of satire are Menippean, Juvenalian, and Horatian. The functions of satire are irony, parody and sarcasm.

a. The types of satire on Simon Armitage's five poem

Simon Armitage's five poems entitled I say I Say I Say, To His Lost Lover, Give, The Golden Toddy, The Jay based on the types of satire containing 20 the data, namely Menippean 7 data, Juvenalian 9 data, and Horatian 4 data.

In the poem entitled I Say I Say I Say, there are five types of satire that is 1st Data: Satire of Menippean, 2nd Data: Satire of Juvenalian, 3th Data: Satire of Horatian, 4th Data: Satire of Juvenalian and 5th Data: Satire of Menippean. In the poem entitled To His Lost Lover, there are five types of satire that is 1st Data: Satire of Menippean, 2nd Data: Satire of Juvenalian, 3th Data: Satire of Juvenalian, 4th Data: Satire of Menippean and 5th Data: Satire of Horatian. In the poem entitled Give there are three types of satire that is 1st Data: Satire of Horatian, 2nd Data: Satire of Juvenalian, and 3th

Data: Satire of Menippean. In the poem entitled The Golden Toddy there are three types of satire that is 1st Data: Satire of Juvenalian, 2nd Data: Satire of Juvenalian, and 3th Data: satire of Horatian. And the last in the poem entitled The Jay there are four types of satire that is: 1st Data: Satire of 69 Juvenalian, 2nd Data: Satire of Menippean, 3th Data: Satire of 69 Juvenalian and 4th Data: Satire of Juvenalian.

b. The function of satire style used on Simon Armitage's five poem

Simon Armitage's five poems entitled I say I Say I Say, To His Lost Lover, Give, The Golden Toddy, The Jay based on the functions of satire. Every point there is five containing 20 data functions of satire. Namely Irony 10 data, parody 2 data, sarcasm 8 data.

In the poem entitled I Say I Say I Say there are five functions of satire that is: 1st Data: Satire of Parody, 2nd Data: Satire of Irony, 3th Data: Satire of Irony, 4th Data: Satire of Sarcasm, and 5th Data: Satire of Sarcasm. In the poem entitled To His Lost Lover there are five functions of satire that is 1st Data: Satire of Irony, 2nd Data: Satire of Sarcasm, 3th Data: Satire of Sarcasm, 4th Data: Satire of Irony, and 5th Data: Satire of irony. In the poem entitled Give there are three functions of satire that is 1st Data: Satire of Sarcasm, 2nd Data: Satire of Irony, and 3th Data: Satire of Sarcasm. In the poem entitled The Golden Toddy there are three functions of satire that is 1st Data: Satire of Irony, 2nd Data: Satire of Sarcasm, and 3th Data: Satire of irony. The last in the poem entitled The Jay there are four functions that is 1st Data: Satire of Irony, 2nd Data: Satire of Sarcasm, 3th Data; Satire of Parody, and 4th Data: Satire of Irony.

After the completing the analysis of satire on Armitage five poems, there are suggestion recommended for:

a. Students

It is recommended for students to read and study this poem to find out the contents of the poem and add insight in literature.

b. Reader
