

## CHAPTER IV

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter present about conclusion and suggestion that are based on the previous discussion of the research. Conclusion is containing answers and problems in the form of an overview of the problem about morphological process of Slang on Jaenglish Language. Meanwhile suggestion is the opinion and suggestion from the Researcher to the reader and next researcher.

#### A. Conclusion

This study is an investigation related with morphological process towards word formation which is contained in the slang word on Jaenglish Language which is widely used by Twitter users. In undertaking this research, the approach taken is a qualitative approach through the perception of word formation theory formulated by George Yule. The theory mentions ten processes; Coinage, Borrowing, Compounding, Blending, Clipping, Back Formation, Conversion, Acronym, Derivation, and Multiple Process. Based on the data obtained from the discussion chapter, there are various slang terms totaling 25 words that can be found in Jaenglish Language, which all of them contain word formation processes and in line with Yule's theory such as Borrowing, Compounding, Blending, Clipping, Acronym, and Multiple Process. More specifically, (1) types of borrowing are found in four slang words, (2) types of compounding are found in six slang words, (3) types of blending are found in one slang word, (4) types of clipping are found in three

slang words, (5) types of acronym are found in eight words terms, and (6) types of multiple process are found in three slang words.

This implied that acronyms are the most dominant word-formation process being used, as they are easy to coined and can shorten long expressions, thus freeing them (the users) from Twitter's character count limitation rules when uploading Tweets. Meanwhile, the word formation processes that cannot be found in Jaenglish Language are coinage, back formation, conversion, and derivation. This proves that there are different functions and formation processes in each type of word formation process. In summary, the Jaenglish Language on Twitter contains a variety of slang terms which formation has gone through a series of morphological processes as well as their creation and use are aiming to strengthen solidarity within a community, free from informal rules, and provide new and creative language styles for users to communicate.

## **B. Suggestion**

After completing the study of the morphological process of slang words found in Jaenglish Language, the researcher can provide suggestions to students, readers, and future researchers who are interested in this topic. First, for students, this research can help students who are conducting research with similar objects, especially the morphological process of slang such as internet slang as reference material. This research also might be giving a new insight to some students to analyze other aspect than morphological process in slang words on Jaenglish Language. Second, for readers this research is useful for readers who do not know the meaning of some internet slang on Jaenglish
