CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter is the last chapter of this research. This chapter consist of two parts, the first is conclusion and the second is suggestion. The conclusion presents a brief explaination of the research result related to the Zarri Bano's Feminism as a main Character in the Holy Woman novel and how are the Zarri Bano's feminism as a main character in the Holy Woman novel based on Kate Millet Perspective. The suggestion section contains recommendation aimed at education of TBI, students of TBI, and further researchers.

A. Conclusion

The analysis result obtained show that there is a feminism character that occurs in the main character in the novel Holy Woman by Qaira Shahraz, namely the elements of id, ego, and superego. Zarri Bano's character in the novel Holy Woman by Qaisra Shahraz is a young woman who is elegent, intelligent, but has an arrogant character. B. Suggestion
