

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTIONS

A. Research Context

Humans as living beings who are given the privilege to be able to think humans can always innovate and continue to develop everything well, especially in education, education is an important thing and it can be said by researchers that every human being cannot be separated from education, they will continue to be tied to each other somehow formal or non-formal education, Formal education is that provided by the educational training system set up or approved by the state for those express purposes.¹ And non-formal education stresses the location of non-formal education outside of educational institutions, or under the authority of an institution that does not adhere to a strict work system and a formal sector accreditation system.²

Education will continue to be a conversation that will continue to exist in society and the world, along with the development of increasingly modern times, education will remain the key to the development itself because education is the most important way for a country to be able to excel. considered as the most strategic field to realize national prosperity. For this reason, a strategy is needed to be able to compete with the outside world, namely by using good language, teaching a foreign language is

English is considered to be one of the languages which are used as an international language, for bridging people's communication, and the most suitable language to use in the education area as a medium of instruction in the teaching and learning process. Learning English as a second language is something new because it is distinctive from learning their native language⁴ so that many institutions take the initiative to establish foreign language courses institutions such as English. According to Triyana in Nawaroh Mahmudah course is a non-formal education unit that purpose as a connection for people who want to get provender knowledge, and attitudes to develop themselves, their profession, and independent Business.⁵

In learning an English foreign language, many strategies can be used by teachers to teach English to their students. According to Charles and James' strategies promoting active learning be defined as instructional activities implicat students in doing things and thinking about what they are doing.⁶ strategies will be a trigger or way in delivering material to students so that students are interested in learning and the material will be delivered

well. One of the strategies that can be used by teachers is group work strategies. According to Burke Groups have more information And more resources to tap into and more knowledge accessible due to the assortment of backgrounds and experiences to source from than individuals.⁷ So that the group will help each other and exchange ideas with each individual.

The use of each method or strategy must be adapted to the lessons that will be taught to students. In group work strategies the researcher finds suitable subjects to apply group work strategies, namely learning Procedure text. According to John Barwick, the main purpose of the procedure is to directly inform and explain how to do something in a sequence of steps.⁸ There are several skills In learning procedure text, procedure text can be done by making written steps or conveying it in practice verbally, the contents of the procedure text must be specified and have clear goals for readers and audiences so that they can re-practice well.⁹

Based on the explanation, the flowers English Center Program at Al-Mujtama' will be used as a place to have research. Flowers English center course is an exclusive program organized by Al-Mujtama' boarding school to facilitate students who want to learn English. According to Alison allden course is usually driven by the academic regulations and structures of a provider and different providers use different lexicons in defining and

describing these structures¹⁰. Flowers English Center Course in the previous procedure text learning they did not use group work strategies but they used individual work strategies. And in the application of individual strategies students have difficulty, and recently group work strategies were used because it was deemed necessary to update strategies In this program, so that students do not find it difficult in learning, and in the application of group work strategies students will be more actively able to discuss and find ways out of difficulties together with the group, especially in learning procedure text.

Many strategies can be used by teachers in learning English, especially in learning procedure text, such as total physical responses, stimulating question strategies, recitation strategies, and others. According to Elizabeth, Patricia, and Claire collaborative learning suggest almost too easy.¹¹ According to David, Roger, and Smith Collaborative learning is the instructional use of small groups so that students work together to escalate their own and each other's learning.¹² There are other terms for this kind of activity, such as cooperative learning, group learning, peer-assisted learning, or team learning.¹³

The researcher choose the topic because some students are not interested in the process of individual learning, especially in learning Procedure Text although the teacher explain and give them the example, they feel that learning Procedure Text by individual learning was difficult for them, when the teacher asked students to practice procedure text to make or to do something, the students do not know about the structure of procedure text and language features of procedure text, they do not know what they will do by practicing procedure text. Therefore in Flowers English Center Course Program of Al-mujtama'Boarding School Plak-Pak Pegantenan Pamekasan in learning Procedure Text the teacher uses group work in learning Procedure Text, the teacher believes that method suitable for making students more understand and active in learning activities, in this case, the teacher used group work Strategies to make the students interested and will not feel bored.¹⁴

Based on the explanation above, researchers are interested in conducting research on group work strategies in learning procedure text because according to Elizabeth more research on learning in groups exists than on any other instructional method. Groups can be identified with particular teaching methods such as the case study method or problem based learning in which the purpose is to accomplish specified cognitive goals

activities, and In this study, the researchers used quantitative research where the results stated that The students' perception of learning English using group work activities at the eleventh grade in MA Muallimin Muhammadiyah Makassar was categorized good perception and good achievement in learning English using group work strategies. It means that the students liked and enjoyed doing group work strategies in the class. And group work strategies the students had the motivation and interest in learning English using group work strategies.²¹ The similarity of this research with the research that the researcher will do is about group work strategies. While the difference is that researchers want to focus on the use of group work strategies in learning procedure text.

Second, the researcher also found the study written by Dea Cellytadara entitled "Students' perception on the influence of group work on the 10th-grade students' achievements in writing and speaking skills at SMA NEGERI 2 KLATEN". This previous study told about Students' perception of the influence of group work and students' achievements in writing and speaking skills. And In this study, the researchers used quantitative research where the results stated that group work make some good influence on their spirit and their achievement in the classroom. And also group work can increase their speaking and writing skills more and they can practice speaking more in a group without any insecurity of making mistakes.²² The
