CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter would like to explain about research context, the research problem, research objective, the significance of study, the definition of key terms, and also the previous study.

A. Research Context

English an international language which shows that English is the language most often used to communicate in this world. In Indonesia itself, English is a foreign language that can be mastered and developed by learning whether it is studying at school, taking courses, or self-taught such as learning from the internet. When students learn English as a foreign language of course students will experience various kinds of difficulties in the learning process because they will listen to and learn a new language that is not the language they use every day. After all, the students will have different perception when learning a foreign language.

Learning a foreign language, especially English will involve the four basic skills, namely speaking, listening, writing, and reading.² Based on these skills several aspects can be taught to students, namely vocabulary, pronunciation, and grammar. When learning, English language aspects and language skills

Listening is the one of the most important skills in English because listening is the one of four basic skills in learning a language. Listening is one of the two most important skills used to be able to communicate with other people. Listening is also one of the most important and frequently done activities in learning lang, especially in learning a foreign language such as English. This is because by listening a person can get the information he needs in learning language skills.³

However, some people believe that listening can be difficult for English learner, especially for nonnative speakers. Based on the writer's interview, the writer found that listening skills are one of the skills considered difficult by the students besides speaking skills. This is because some students are not able to convey what they hear in sentences. Some students try to record what they hear to find the main idea of what they listen to the most common problems that most likely make students not make or do not understand enough in listening. This is because the media or methods used by the teacher make students bored, bad impact on the students will make students lazy and less motivated to learn English.

The podcast is an audio or audio-visual that can be used using an internet connection or video itself is a medium that can be used for the learning process

According to another statement by Faiza and Wawan, podcasts an effective media because they can be used as varied learning media, the tools needed are simple, easy to find, can be heard anytime and anywhere. The use of podcasts will greatly impact language learning, especially English, this is because podcasts have several features that can attract students interest, such as selection of various themes, and can be adapted to the needs and desires of teachers and students. Podcasts are a new media or tool in world of education will result in many students' perception and assumptions about application of podcasts as media or tool in learning English.

From the results of several English students at MA Miftahul Miftahul Ulum Kebun Wangi, there are still many students who have difficulty learning to listen to English, as result, students are not motivated to learning to listen to English. Several course difficulties in learning to listen to English students, namely lack of vocabulary students afraid being wrong in conveying what they listen to, and feeling embarrassed to convey the information they listen to in English.

Therefore, teachers are looking for ways to make the learning English listening process more effective, one of the which is by using English podcasts in teaching listening can be seen through students' perception. Perceptions can be described as being able to improve students' listening skills or not, when learning by using English podcasts.

Several researchers have researched students' perception of using English podcasts. One of researched by Putri Awalia with the title "Students' Perception on The Use of English Podcast in Listening Comprehension". This research examines the use of English podcasts in language elements and other skills. The researcher used survey research with the help of two instruments, namely questionnaires, and interviews. The purpose of this research was to increases the choice of teaching resources for teachers and students.

In this case, the researcher wants to conduct different research to explore students, perceptions and views about learning English by listening to podcasts.

F. Previous Research

In compiling this research, the researcher considers several relevant studies to support this research, that are:

Firstly, research by Sukmawati, the title of the research "The Use of English Podcast Application to Improve Students' Listening Skills". Based on the findings and discussions this research is qualitative, this study shows that the use of podcasts a significant and positive impact on the development of students listening skills in English. The research conducted by Sukmawati found the results that the use of English podcasts applications can have a positive influence and can improve students listening comprehension skills.¹³ The

Secondly, research by Nurningsih, the tittle of the research "Students' Perceptions on Using Podcast to Learn Listening at The MTS Negri 1 Mataram". The research is qualitative descriptive based on the finding and result of this study from discussion conducted by the researcher regarding students' perceptions of the using podcast for the learning to listen at MTS Negri 1 Mataram can be conducted student perception of using podcast to learn to listen are cauterized be oppositive with a high percentage of class IX-1 and IX-2 with the highest percentage value 64.06% with 41 students aggreging. In addition, the use of podcast has benefits. Something helped increase comprehension, pronunciation rich vocabulary and fun. However, using podcast has drawback, there is unfamiliar accent that makes it difficult for students to understand. The similarity of this research with Nurningsih's research is that they both examine students' perceptions of using podcasts. The difference between this research and Nurningsih's research is that this research is qualitative, while Nurningsih's research is quantitative.

The podcast media to develop students listening skills can provide new strategies for students to be more active in learning to increase their listening skills. Light learning strategies make students not feel bored, and enthusiasm for learning increases. The similarity of this research with Fadlan Chairuddin Lubis's research is that they both research the use of podcasts, while the difference between this research with Fadlan Chairuddin Lubis's research is qualitative and focus on students' perception of using podcasts, while Fadlan Chairuddin Lubis's research is experimental and focuses on the use of podcasts.

Related to the previous studies, the researcher will conduct research that is different from the previous research. This research will describe the perception with are focus on the opinions and views of students about learning to listen to English talk podcasts. The researcher made the special title for this research namely "Students' Perception Towards the Use of English Podcasts for Listening Comprehension at the Twelfth Grades Students of MA Miftahul Ulum Kebun Wangi Bluuran Karangpenang Sampang".
