CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

The descriptions of introduction in chapter one are the background of the study, problems of study, objective of study, assumption of the study, hypothesis of study, significant of the study, the scope and limitation of the study and definitions of key terms.

A. Background Of Study

Learning English is very important on all sides of human life. English is an international language that is often needed wherever we are. As well as in offices, schools, hotels, offices and in crowded places. English is also required to be taught in various schools, both public and private. The purpose of the learning is to meet the purpose of the influence of the English language. Which is to fulfill the role of English in itself and also the encouragement to achieve maximum learning achievement. In learning English, there are four language skills and also language components that teachers must teach students, namely listening, speaking, reading, writing, pronunciation, vocabulary, and also grammar. Skills and components are very important in developing language competence. When motivation and supportive environment, then students' will be easier to understand the four skills and students should be able to use English in real communication (practice). Student achievement is the achievement of students' in the process of teaching and learning activities by bringing changes and information about one's behavior. Learning achievement as a measurement of the assessment of learning activities or learning processes expressed in symbols, letters and sentences that have been achieved by each child in a certain period of time. Students' achievement in the assessment of learning activities. The learning can be in the form of numbers, symbols or letters that can reflect the results that students have achieved in a certain period of time.

Slameto said that learning a process of effort made by a person to obtain a new behavior change as a whole, as a result of his own experience in interaction with his environment. According to Sugihartono in teaching and learning activities, learning outcomes are intended to know how far students' behavior changes after following the learning process. The measurements performed by the teacher use the test as a measuring instrument. The measurement results are in the

form of numbers or statements that reflect the mastery of the subject matter for students', better known as learning achievements. According to Arikunto measurement of learning, achievement can be done by various ways of providing tests that have a function that is to measure students' abilities and the success of teaching programs based on the score results of the tests that have been given. ¹

Because in this study, researchers will collect data to establish a hypothesis, the first researcher used the questioner to determine data on the correlation between parents' motivation and students' learning achievement, and the second documentation to collect data on students' results related to students' achievement in class. The Second previous study there is Thesis Written By An Nisa Arya Utami as Her Thesis Entitled "The Correlation of Students' Mental Health and English Learning Achievement". She conclude that the level of mental health in the tenth-grade students of SMAN 3 Bone majority was in mild category (45.45%) and the level of English learning achievement was in the good category (45.45%). It showed that the majority of the students' have a high level of mental health and English achievement. The Similarities of the previous study with this research about English learning achievement.
