### A. Types of Bad words used in Peaky Blinders series Season1. Eps.1.

Based on research method above, researcher have to watch and collecting data from the main source which is Peaky Blinders Series and found some good data related with Bad words to completing the first research focused have mentioned earlier on this research

Batistella have their own prospective dividing bad words the first is epithets, profanity, vulgarity, and obscenity<sup>60</sup>.

#### a. Ephitets

Epithet is characterized by the existence of several types of slurs, such as bitch and fag. Other references that are included as epithet are connected to race, ethnicity, gender, sexuality, one's appearance, and disabilities such as nigger, madget and retard,

## b. Profanity

According to Batistella, profanity can be categorized as religious cursing because it usually includes the foul-mouthed use of what is considered to be sacred<sup>63</sup>. Being more detail, Jay in Doyle describes profanity as the expression involving

the use of religious terms in a profane, secular or uncaring manner. The aim of the speaker is not to vilify God or anything connected with religion but it may be used to express emotional response to certain motives<sup>64</sup>. This term is proposed to mock people using insult their religion sacred, the words that belong to this type are Jesus Christ, hell, damn, goddamn. This strategy is used to attack someone's face who wants to be acknowledged as a part of the society.

## c. Vulgarity

Vulgarity and obscenity have the same reference especially to words or expressions that contain sexual anatomy and excretory function in a rough manner<sup>65</sup>. The difference between vulgarity and obscenity is usually related to the level of prurience. Jay asserts that vulgarity is used to humiliate or bring down the thing or individual referred to or described. Almost similar with previous type but vulgarity such an type that proposed to bring down the mental of listener. The words that belong to this type are such as ass, tat, cock, dick, and crot<sup>66</sup>.

Obscenity refers to the expressions that are prohibited from public use since they involve repulsion to the sense, abhorrent, impolite and detestable to morality<sup>67</sup>. Moreover, according to Batistella profanity is defined as words or expression which involve sex differentiating anatomy or sexual and excretory function that usually uttered in rough manner<sup>68</sup>. Including some sex utterance when communicate each other indicate detestable of moral of speaker. The words that belong to this type are fuck and shit.

### A. Function of Bad words used in *Peaky Blinders* Series Season1. Eps.1

After researcher mentioned the kinds of impoliteness strategies here we will mention the function of impoliteness strategies used in this series, According to culpaper there are 3 function of impoliteness They are affective impoliteness, coercive impoliteness, and entertaining impoliteness. <sup>69</sup>

### 1. To Draw Attention To One Self

Sometimes people utter taboo words in order to get the attention from the listener. Mc Edward explains that the speakers should gain the interest trough the use of strong, powerful language whose connotation can stimulate an instant reaction from the audience<sup>70</sup>. Therefore, people use taboo words which are believed to have power in gaining listener's attention because of its strong

## 2. To Show Contempt

The use of taboo words in conversation between two people which is listener and speaker can that show contempt. contempt means the impression in which a person or may be something is totally useless and cannot be regarded. In other words, when someone tries to show contempt by using taboo words, he or she will insult the addressee by uttering words that can offend their pride

There were two examples on the Peaky Blinders Series Season

1 Eps 1 scenes which indicates bad words purposing to show contempt

The first is when inspectur Campbell first came to the Birmingham police office, on his speech he called officers as a bastard who spoiled their own uniforms, and it is clearly to mock and to show his new authirity in this institution

Inspectur Campbell: God damn you for soiling your uniforms!!

## 3. To be Provocative

Provocative means here to get angry listener because of our words and in another word speaker words become provocative to make specific respond in speaker. This is in line with Rothwell who says that verbal obscenity can be the most efficient symbolic process offered to protester intended for inviting chaotic reaction<sup>71</sup>.
